Acadian began operations in 1971 with two ambulances and eight medics covering 279 square miles of rural Louisiana. Our service area features a diverse geography of rich swamps, bayous and marshlands, making quick response by ground a difficult task. As a result, Acadian launched a medical air division in 1981.

Today, our ambulance division provides highly skilled medical care to more than 25 million residents over 57,000 square miles in Louisiana, Mississippi, Texas, and Tennessee. Acadian's medical air fleet flies more first-response air missions than any other air medical service in the United States. Our fleet of more than 650 ambulances, EC-135 and 145 helicopters, and Beechcraft King Air turboprops and Bombardier Learjet 45 aircraft are all equipped with advanced life-saving equipment and staffed by expert flight paramedics, nurses, drivers and pilots. Acadian transports approximately 700,000 patients and travels 30 million miles each year, enough to circumnavigate the earth 41 times each day.

Acadian's ground operations are accredited by CAAS and our rotor-wing air operations are accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Medical Transport Systems (CAMTS), signifying that Acadian sets the gold standard determined by the medical transport industry. Acadian Companies is proud to be one of the very few ambulance services in the nation to hold both CAAS and CAMTS accreditations.

Acadian has been recognized as one of the nation's best emergency medical service providers. The use of innovative technology, stringent medical protocols, and exceptional high standards has earned the company numerous honors and led us to become one of the most respected and largest employee-owned medical providers in the nation.



As a recognized leader in EMS, Acadian's in-house education department has often been asked to provide training for other EMS and government agencies.

With the expansion of our educational capabilities, Acadian launched the National EMS Academy in 2003. Fully accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP), the academy collaborates with South Louisiana Community College (SLCC) and Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service (TEEX) to educate Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) and paramedics for agencies across the United States.

The National EMS Academy offers entry-level, continuing education and refresher courses for a number of EMS career paths. Hybrid EMT and paramedic programs combine online instruction and exams and in-person skills training, allowing students to have more flexibility in pursuing their goals.

As an authorized American Heart Association training center, the academy provides cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and emergency cardiovascular care courses year-round.

As a leading resource for EMS professionals who seek excellence in educational offering, the academy strives to produce highly effective curricula and teaching resources while committing to quality research in medical education.


Over time, the division's offerings greatly expanded to offer a comprehensive range of services to address various safety and environmental needs, catering to industries and organizations requiring specialized support.

As Hurricane Ida's projected path threatened the Southeastern Louisiana coast in late August of 2021, Acadian's team answered the call to duty. Our Emergency Response Operations Center (EROC) team mobilized to coordinate incoming evacuation requests while our operations and support teams implemented plans to protect community buildings, vehicles, and personnel. We worked under state contracts and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) deployments using our resources to safely perform over 800 evacuations from nursing homes, assisted living facilities, private residences and hospitals. With the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic, our teams focused on the mission. Acadian added numerous hurricane strike teams to assist with medical testing, transport, and hospital space overflow. During the storm, our qualified medical teams sheltered with first responders to remain readily available for the community at risk.

Following the storm, many of our team members worked for several days before leaving to survey their personal property damage. They were needed to help the community and answered the call. Our teams exemplified "The Acadian Way", answering the call of the community with compassion and integrity.

Today, Acadian Federal Resources is prepared to provide emergency response services for operations across the country, with an expanding international presence. Our expansive capabilities include: medical safety, and logistics staffing; utility infrastructure; air and ground transport; supplies and equipment for medical facilities; security and asset tracking; and safety and logistics management. Acadian services have been instrumental in the operations of mass casualty incidents, storm recovery efforts, migrant intake facilities, and more. Our personnel are trained to provide the most effective care possible whether they are operating from brick and mortar facilities, field hospitals, or in mobile strike teams.

A Proven History of Response

Acadian Ambulance Service began operations in Lafayette, Louisiana, on September 1, 1971. Since then, our company has expanded to include diverse divisions that share a spirit of innovation and contribute to our mission of Knowing Life Matters.

Acadian Ambulance Service, Acadian Air Med, Executive Aircraft Charter Service, Safety Management Systems, National EMS Academy, Acadian Total Security, and Acadian Health comprise Acadian Companies, and together, we have more than 5,300 employee-owners.

Acadian Companies has remained at the forefront of using advanced technology and stringent medical protocols and training. We have accomplished many notable "firsts" in our storied history.

We were the first ambulance service to formalize training for EMTs and paramedics. In 1976, the National Registry of EMTs adopted our IV training program and began using it nationwide.

In 1989, we partnered with the University of Southwestern Louisiana (now University of Louisiana at Lafayette) in the first scientifically controlled study of an external pacemaker.


Our company has also led the way in the use of technology. We were granted the first Federal Communications Commission (FCC) license to transmit electrocardiogram (EKG) telemetry from a remote location to a hospital.

In a partnership with the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA), we were the first to use a satellite to establish communications between medics on offshore oil rigs to hospitals onshore.

We became one of the first to launch a telemedicine program, allowing physicians at a computer terminal in an emergency room to view high-resolution video images transmitted from paramedics offshore.

The Acadian story is one of dedication, perseverance, resilience, caring, and compassion.

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
